

WHO SHOULD APPLY

All awards, services and benefits of the ACF will be offered solely to residents of Oregon who are members of the Independent Christian Church/Church of Christ and enroll in an affiliated Christian college or seminary in preparation for a full time career in ministry.

All candidates must have a cumulative grade point average of at least 3.0.



How to Apply

A completed application must be submitted by April 1st accompanied by:

- an evaluation of character and direction from the minister of the applicant's home church
- an evaluation of character and direction from an elder from the applicant's home church
- a transcript of high school and/or college grades
- an essay on the subject, "Why I desire to serve Christ in a church related vocation."
- a photo of applicant

A Scholarship Committee appointed by the Board of Directors will review the applications and recommend selected scholarship recipients to the ACF Board of Directors. All applicants will be notified of the decision concerning their application by June 15th.

WHAT IS A SCHOLARSHIP?

Scholarships are payments to support a student's education that do not need to be repaid. ACF has awarded 140 scholarships (a total of \$95,250) to 62 students attending 10 different Christian Colleges from 1993-2018.

Scholarships are awarded based upon criteria such as ministry choice, financial need, elder's and minister's evaluation, grade point average and written essay.

What kinds of scholarships are awarded by the ACF?

The Basic Grant:

The Basic Grant Scholarship in the amount of \$500 is awarded for one year for undergraduate studies at a Christian College.

Other Grants:

Other scholarships may be awarded in various amounts on a yearly basis as determined by the directors and upon availability of funds.
